To follow working on reducing pollution and improving the creation of an increasingly sustainable system, we are working in 2022 on the following environmental objectives

1

Establishment of DF ELECTRIC's environmental requirements for all our suppliers and subcontractors We achieve to the 49% of our suppliers and 100% of our subcontractors in 2022.

We have planned to increase the number of suppliers in 2023.

2

Reduction of consumption and generation of hazardous waste We implemented a new inkjet marking process for cylindrical fuses in 2022. We have planned to implement for all cylindrical sizes in 2023. We planned to implement a new laser marking process for fuseholders in 2023.

We have reduced the 10% of hazardous waste in 2022 and we have planned to increase the reduction in 2023.

Reduction of electricity consumption

We have installed 549 photovoltaic panels at the beginning of 2023. We have achieve self-consumption of 300 Kw.

With this investment, we expect to have a considerable reduction in electricity this year.

Digital implementation and reduction of paper consumption

We have implemented the Informatics system in the entire production and digitalization of all financial documentation in 2022.

We have reduced about 30% of paper consumption and we expect to reduce more in 2023.


